

Fr. Lürssen Werft Lemwerder

Our site in Lemwerder is our primary ship construction site and also home to our training workshop and central warehouse. With several shipbuilding sheds, a modern slipway and shifting area as well as a 550-meter-long pier, our 148,000-square meter production area is perfectly designed for constructing and refitting yachts up to 110 meters long.



Fr. Lürssen Werft Bremen-Aumund

This shipyard was acquired by the Lürssen Group in 1997. Today it features a covered dry dock that is 170 meters long and a 220-meter floating dock. Here in Aumund, we can construct and modernize yachts up to 200 metres and longer. An outfitting workshop and a 180-meter-long pier bring the total area of this shipyard to 75,000 square meters.



Fr. Lürssen Werft Berne

Lürssen acquired this shipyard in 2010. It is home to a 164-meter-long floating dock and a synchrolift capable of hoisting 4,800 tons, as well as modern production and outfitting sheds. This site is specifically designed and optimized for the repair, restoration, maintenance and conversion of yachts and complements our high-performance portfolio at the Bremen site.



Lürssen-Kröger Werft

Back in 1986, we expanded our yacht-building capacities with a new shipyard in Schacht-Audorf near Rendsburg. Today, this newbuild and refit yard on the Kiel Canal features three shipbuilding sheds, a covered slipway, a synchrolift, two floating docks with lengths of 128 and 140 meters and a 250-meter-long pier. The shipyard is used to construct and refit yachts up to 110 metres long.



Blohm+Voss

The Lürssen Group acquired Blohm+Voss, a landmark in the port of Hamburg, in 2016. The shipyard specialises in complex and time-critical repair, conversion and refit projects of various ship classes, including Mega Yachts, Cruise Liners, Merchant and Naval Vessels. Among its extensive facilities, the shipyard features seven docks supported by cranes with lifting capacities of up to 50 tons: one massive dry dock (351 x 59 m), four floating docks between 162 and 329 metres and two covered docks between 143 and 160 metres in length.



Norderwerft

The Lürssen Group acquired this repair yard in the Port of Hamburg in 2012. It is dedicated to providing a comprehensive range of repair, restoration, maintenance and conversion services for a wide variety of ship classes – from merchant and naval vessels to yachts and government and research ships. Among its many facilities, the shipyard features ten dock cranes and three floating docks measuring 118, 150 and 164 meters.



Neue Jadewerft

This shipyard in the tideless port of Wilhelmshaven was acquired by the Lürssen Group in 2004 and specializes in the repair, restoration, maintenance and conversion of a wide variety of ship classes, including yachts up to 150 meters. The Neue Jadewerft site features a 150-meter floating dock, a slipway, a shipbuilding shed and a construction hall, as well as a 300-meter pier, making it an ideal site for repairing larger vessels.



